Why is Good Grip Important?

Good writing and coloring grip helps children write and color with more ease, accuracy, and speed.

Children with poor grip might often demonstrate difficulty completing written assignments such as worksheets, copying from the blackboard, or completing tests.

Children with poor grip might also experience increased frustration with written activities due to hand and finger fatigue.
